Registration

This year, players will be able to register on-line from 18th January. Instructions for this simple process are attached. To register you will need your FFA number and a password - these will be emailed separately. If you have any issues with registering, please contact registrar@beecroftfc.com.au.

We still have face-to-face registration sessions planned. Come along to one of these if you are registering a new player, needing a new photo taken, would like to buy club shorts/socks, would like help with registering online or would just like to be sociable.

The dates are: Wednesday 1st February 6-8pm or Sunday 5th February 1-5pm, at the Beecroft Bowling Club, Copeland Rd.

Fees

Fees cover FFA/FNSW/GHFA/NWSWF charges, referees, compulsory insurance, shirts, training & playing ground hire, administrative officer, equipment and trophies.

All new Minis players will be given a soccer ball. The U6 & U7 registration fee includes Kickstart training on Monday evenings.

Fees will need to be paid before your registration is accepted by the Club. Payment online, at time of registration, with credit card (Visa or Mastercard) is the easiest and preferred option. Should you decide to withdraw from Beecroft FC after registering, full fees may not be refunded. Please see the Fees & Refund Policy on our website for details.

We offer a 30% discount on the 4th (& subsequent) registrations from the same family. Please pay the full fee at the time of registering and then send an email to the Registrar who will arrange a refund for you. The discount is applied to the most expensive registration fee.
